Showmanship How to stand out from the rest of the class. By Trish Lanoux

Showmanship is one of the largest and fastest growing classes in APHA approved shows. It's often a competitor's first class of the day and an opportunity to put their best foot forward in front of their judges. But how does one clean pattern win over another exhibitor's clean pattern? We've spoken with two APHA carded judges and they have shared their Do's and Don'ts as well as how they score a class and how an exhibitor can stand out.

Judge Susan Stafford's biggest pluses in a showmanship pattern are a neat and clean turnout of both the horse and handler, showing that they are both prepared for the class. Having a pleasant attitude is also a big positive in her book. Her biggest turn offs in a pattern are over showing, not being in sync with you horse and excessive clucking. Judge Stafford also see's answering "yeah" or "Sir" or "No Ma'am" to a judge as a negative marks. "nope" instead of "Yes big No No and results in

pattern with all of these things can start the pattern off with + marks, or—ones if an exhibitor fails to start off on the right foot. The rest of the maneuvers are marked with + or— marks accordingly. The second most important part of judging a showmanship pattern for Judge Neff is the set up. If good it can double the positive marks and it will break any tie for him.

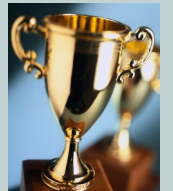
